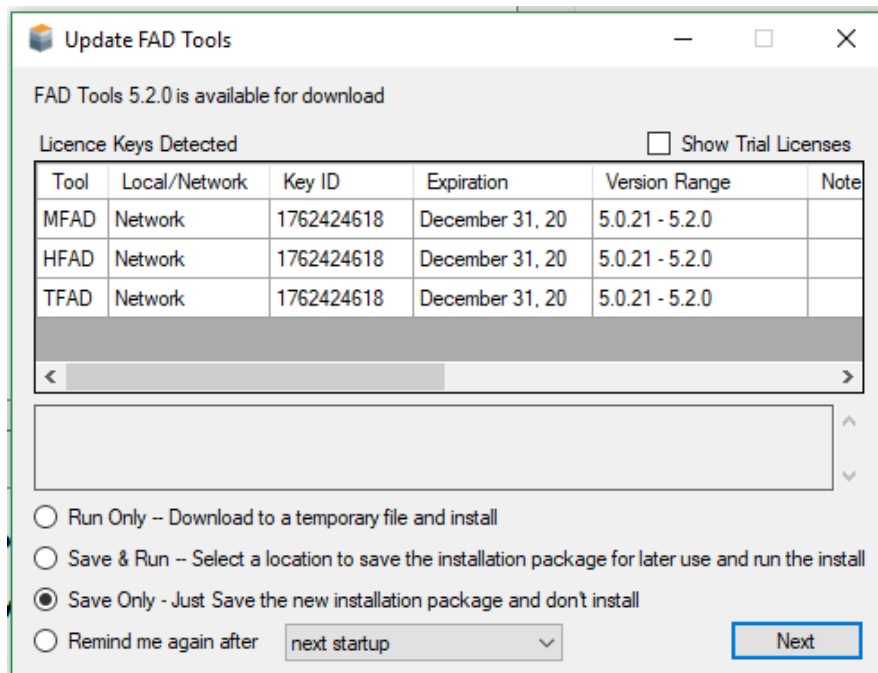


Checking for Updates

FAD Tools is designed to check for updates once a day when you first open the software. If there is an update available it will automatically update.

If you do not receive an automatic update you can check your license information by clicking the *Help* menu and selecting *View License Information*. The pop-up window displays your current key information including Key ID number, subscription expiration date and min/max version range. Your version range should state the max version as 5.2.0 if you have a current subscription, see below.



There are four options to download the software. Choose the install option that best suits your needs. Note, the installer of FAD 5.2.0 will not over write FAD 5.1.18 or your existing database files. You can also click the *Help* menu and select *Check for Updates*. This calls into the FAD Tools license service and checks that your key information matches the current version of FAD Tools installed. If there is an update available it will automatically install. If your software is up to date you will receive a notice saying "FAD Tools is up to date...".
